> California Adult Education Program Updates and Deliverables

- May 2, 2020 CFADs for 2020-21 were due in NOVA.
 - Oue to the COVID-19 Pandemic there is a possibility of the 2.29% COLA not being in the final budget. CAERC, and all consortia, have been advised by the CAEP Office to proceed as if the cost of living adjustment would take place. Unfortunately, the budget proposal will not be known until the May revise. If any changes need to be made they will happen after July 1, 2020 in the Allocation amendment process. The May revise and the June version of the California state budget will still not be final until possibly the end of summer. This is because the tax deadline was moved to July and the economic effects of COVID-19 disruption will affect the overall income for the state.

• Branka Marceta introduced Renee Collins as the new Director of Adult Education for the Sacramento County Office of Education.

Fact Sheets

- Washington Adult School's fact sheet is set up like the previous fact sheets that have been completed and shared. The majority of their students are between 18-29 and primarily female. 75% of their funding comes from the California Adult Education Program.
- Center's Adult School has 229 students enrolled for 2018-19 and 61% of their students are non-English speakers. 13 high school diplomas and equivalencies were earned and 9 pre-apprenticeship certificates were earned. 70% of their funding comes from the California Adult Education Program.
- The general CAERC fact sheet covers the 12 members who offer programs. The format for this fact sheet is a little different than the others in order to incorporate each member logo. During 2018-19 we served 13,921 students according to

CASAS TOPSpro Enterprise records. 58% of these students are non-native speakers. 98% of students have one or more employment barriers. This data point is listed on the CAERC fact sheet for the whole region, and was not included in the individual member's fact sheets.

- Dr. Herota pointed out that the percentages for why students are primarily enrolled doesn't add up to 100%. Bethany believes it's a rounding issue and she will fix it.
- Dr. Herota questioned whether we need the PO box listed on the fact sheet. If it was removed the logos would be able to be a little larger and more spread out. Bethany will make the adjustments.

The applications will be e-mailed out to all members and they will be discussed during Friday's Director's Workgroup meeting. During the meeting we will be reviewing the applications and discussing the awarding of the \$300,000.
